As a provider of interstate and/or international assessable U.S. telecommunications or interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol services, FIRSTLIGHT FIBER, INC. To the extent COMPANY exempts CUSTOMER from the payment of FUSF Fees based on this Certification and COMPANY subsequently determines that the exemption was granted based on inaccurate or incomplete information provided by CUSTOMER, COMPANY may bill CUSTOMER for the amount of FUSF Fees that would have been billed in the absence of the exemption, plus any applicable late fees. If billed, CUSTOMER agrees to promptly pay COMPANY any such charges. CUSTOMER will indemnify and hold harmless COMPANY against any and all claims arising out of the information, representations and/or certifications provided by CUSTOMER in this Certification.

3. CUSTOMER has a continuing obligation to maintain the accuracy of this Certification, and for keeping it up-to-date at all times throughout the receipt of services from COMPANY. Failure to keep the Certification current, or if the Certification is inaccurate and/or incomplete, CUSTOMER will be subject to FUSF Fees for all services previously exempted from FUSF Fees.

4. CUSTOMER acknowledges that COMPANY may provide a copy of this Certification to the Universal Service Administrator, the FCC or any authorized auditor.
